## Beta New IM Grid Champs

Beta emerged as the champion of intramural football by humbling Sigma Chi, 26-0, last Tuesday, Nov. 23, at South Field. The game remained close until the Beta bombshell burst in the fourth quarter.

Beta's first score came shortly after the game started when Sam Pardoe latched onto a 40-yard pass from Jim Davies, the first of his four touchdown tosses. The attempt for the extra point failed, and Beta took the lead, 6-0.

After two quarters of scoreless play during which Sigma Chi continually threatened but was unable to score, Larry Lindner intercepted a pass to stop a Sigma Chi threat. The Beta offense, which had failed to function in the previous quarter, suddenly took fire and in the second TD on another Davies to Pardoe pass play. Al Vlerebome's kick made the score, 13-0.

Davies intercepted a pass soon after Sigma Chi put the ball in play and Beta again had possession of the pigskin. Fast to capitalize on this break, Beta Dan Rich caught a long pass again from Davies, for the third score. Verebome's boot was good once more and the score increased to 20-0.

The fired-up Beta squad hit paydirt for the last time with only one and a half minutes remaining in play. Rich was again on the receiving end of a Davies' pass and added the six points. The extra point was missed, making the final score, 26-0.

## Winter Intramural Leagues Set, Some Teams Already Underway

Freshman basketball started yesterday and bowling begins Saturday. All freshman basketball games will be played Tuesdays and frosh bowling will be on Saturdays. Last year SAE won basketball and Phi Psi won bowling.

The first round of freshman golf has been completed. However, because of poor playing conditions through the winter, it will not be completed until Spring. Intramural wrestling will be held during the month of December, while the date of the swimming meet is once again undetermined. The meet was originally scheduled for Dec. 4 and Dec. 11, but varsity meets have taken priority.
